

UPPER PRIMARY SCHOOL Entrance Exam Requirements

Going to Grade 2

Math

- Count from 0 to 100 and write the corresponding numerals; and write the corresponding numeral to develop an understanding of place value
- Count forward by ones, twos, fives, and tens to 100
- Compare a two-digit numeral, and a three digit numeral
- Solve a one-step addition and subtraction problems, using data from simple tables, picture graphs, and bar graphs
- Tell time to the half-hour, using analog and digital clocks
- Identify plane geometric figures (triangle, square, rectangle, and circle) according to number of sides, vertices, and right angles
- Interpret information displayed in a picture or object graph, using the vocabulary *more, less, fewer, greater than, less than, and equal to*
- Recognize repeating patterns
- Add a two-digit number to a two-digit number using models or mental math
- Subtract a two-digit number from a two-digit number using models or mental math
- Write the addition and subtraction sentences that make up a fact family
- To identify equal parts of a whole
- Identify solid figures
